






# Computing School Improvement Priorities 2022 - 2023




Introduce staff and pupils to the Teach Computing curriculum, ensuring all know of the topics and areas of computing that they will be teaching or being taught.




Continue to work with staff, pupils, school governors and parents to further enhance effective communication through the school website.




Ensure that the Digital Literacy – online safety aspect of computing is fully embedded and drawn upon across all curriculum areas when relevant.




Through pupil voice, gathered during lesson observations and deep dives, gain pupil views and opinions regarding the computing curriculum.




Ensure that the Teach Computing curriculum is being delivered effectively through lesson observations and dialogue with staff.
