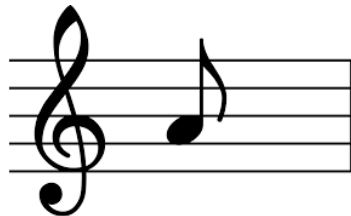
History
