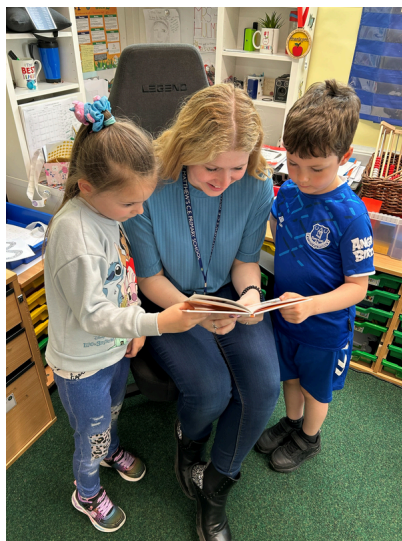
I'm delighted to start us off as Head of English and Year 1/2 teacher. One of my all-time favourite childhood books is *The Tiger Who Came to Tea*.
