Mr Bailey's Book Recommendation

For my chosen book or collection of books, it has to be the Goosebump series of books. Whilst I tend not to read these types of books now, when I was a child, I used to love them because they hit a very good balance that a lot of kids love: scary enough to feel exciting, but safe enough to still stay fun...and not real! The author of most of the books, R.L. Stine, created horror that introduces suspense and tension without graphic violence. For many readers, Goosebumps is their first experience with the horror genre and it certainly did this for me...even though I am not a fan of adult horror films especially! The stories usually focus on ordinary kids dealing with bizarre situations, which makes the horror feel personal without becoming too overwhelming for the reader with many of the books ending with a surprise reveal or dark joke that sticks in your memory. Overall, I highly recommend these books for Year 4 and upwards, especially if you love a good mystery or horror story...if you're not too scared?!

You have worked for BBC and others. You've helped many charities and many, many animals.

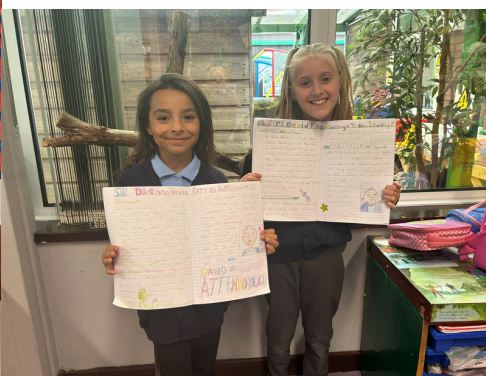
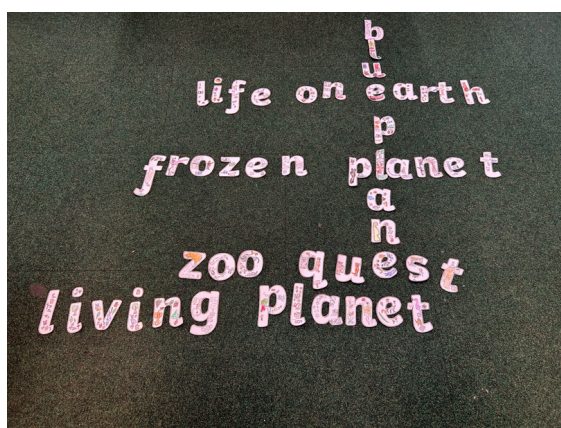
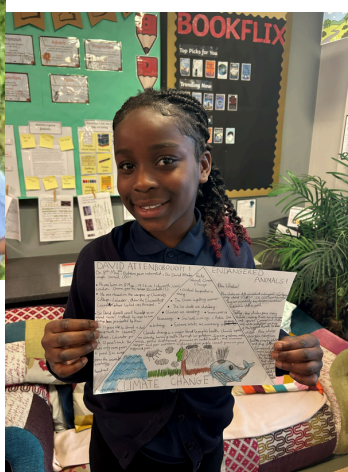
Many species of animals are named after you, such as :
