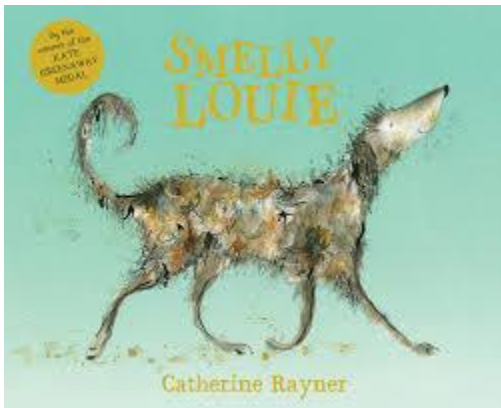

Monday – Listen to the story and have a go at the activity sheet attached below to begin to think about adding your own text to the story. (This does not have to be printed out and the suggestions can simply be recorded in the home learning book.)

Tuesday – Using yesterday's ideas can you have a go at writing your sentences to add to the story.

Wednesday – Today it would be great if you could illustrate your writing, using whatever media you have available (paint, colouring pens, collage etc.) to go with your added part to the story. (If these could be photographed and popped onto Seesaw with your writing, I would love to have a look at your suggestions.)

Thursday – Listen to the story again today, have a go at creating a storyboard for the events in the story using your own drawings.

Friday – Use your story board to re-tell the story of Louie to your family, you could simply speak or even get them involved and act it out using yourselves or some toys, try and remember to use the language from the story such 'The Ponky Pond' and 'Sticky Sludge', maybe even add in your own descriptions.

Reading – Please read as often as you can with your child during this time home learning, whether that be you reading to them or allowing them to make up stories from books you may have in the home. Oxford owl provides many books at a range of different abilities so enjoy.
