





RE assessment at St. Matthew's

Primary RE assessment means assessing children's knowledge of religious education (RE) at the end of each key stage. At St Matthew's school, teacher assessment is a core part of RE assessment and is carried out at the end of each unit of work which is used to make a termly teacher assessment judgment entered into the school's OTrack system. This is then analysed by the RE Lead and Assessment Lead (Deputy Head). At the end of each unit the teacher uses the title page to assess each child's knowledge and understanding of the units learning objectives. This then informs the teachers judgment of whether the child is WTS (apprentice), ARE (skilled) or GDS (Expert).
