I know

- Living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- I know how to explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.
- I know that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers and have an impact on living things.



What is the Trinity? – (Digging Deeper)

Pupils know that Christians believe God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Father creates; he sends the Son who saves his people; and the Holy Spirit on his people. Christians believe the Holy Spirit is God's power at work in the world and in their lives today, enabling them to follow Jesus

- Pupils know that Christians often try to describe God using symbols, similes, and metaphors, in song, story, poems and art and have created art to help to express this belief.
- Pupils know the story of Jesus Baptism (Matthew 3; 11-17) including that Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist that a voice came from above and the dove appeared. They know the symbolism this suggests.
- Pupils can describe a Christian Baptism (child and adult) including the terminology of 'in the name of the father, the son and the Holy spirit'
