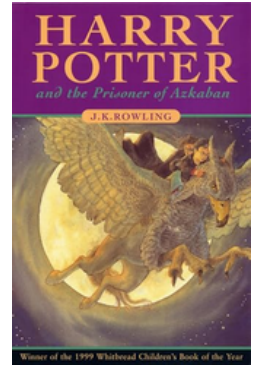
## Mrs Barfield's Favourite Book

Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban follows Harry in his third year at Hogwarts, where things feel more mysterious, a bit dark, and definitely more grown up than before. A dangerous prisoner named Sirius Black has escaped from Azkaban, and everyone believes he's coming after Harry. Because of this, the wizard guards called Dementors are placed around Hogwarts - creatures that make people feel cold, scared and hopeless.

As the school year goes on, Harry, Ron and Hermione notice strange clues about Sirius Black and the past. Hermione is acting oddly, disappearing at times and taking far more classes than seems possible. Ron's pet rat is behaving strangely too. The trio slowly uncover secrets that change everything Harry thought he knew about his family.

The story builds toward an exciting and surprising twist, showing that not everything - or everyone - is what they seem. It's a book full of friendship, bravery and learning to face fear, making it one of the most memorable adventures in the series.

I loved listening to my Year 5 teacher read this book to my class when I was in primary school, it was lovely on a rainy afternoon in a warm classroom to sit and listen to her read it.
