Patshull Park Farm

Our trip to Patshull Farm was full of excitement and discovery from the moment we arrived.

We had great fun building shelters and creating different types of habitats, carefully thinking about what each living thing would need to survive. It was a brilliant way to link everything back to what we've been learning in science about life cycles, growth and the conditions animals depend on.

The farm itself was bursting with life, and as we explored, we were able to meet a wonderful variety of animals, including pigs, goats, sheep and chickens. One of the biggest surprises of the day was discovering that the farm is home to an incredible 10,000 chickens – a number that felt even bigger when we saw them spread across the fields in every direction.

The whole experience helped bring our learning to life in a memorable and hands-on way, and it gave us a real appreciation for the work that goes into caring for so many animals.

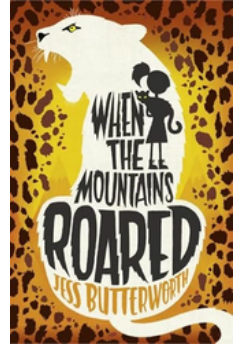

“When the Mountains Roared” written by Jess Butterworth, combines adventure, emotion and friendship that keeps you wanting to read more. This book also shares important environmental issues in the world, and how humans can affect nature and why endangered animals deserve our help.



The story follows Ruby, a girl who moves from Australia to live a new life in the mountains of India when her father becomes the manager of a new hotel. After first moving to this new place, Ruby feels frightened, angry and lonely. As the story develops, she discovers that local leopards are being threatened by poachers and decides to help protect them, even though she has many fears of her own. Through this journey, Ruby learns to become brave and confident.
