And of course a big thank you to our staff who have also had to endure very difficult working conditions.

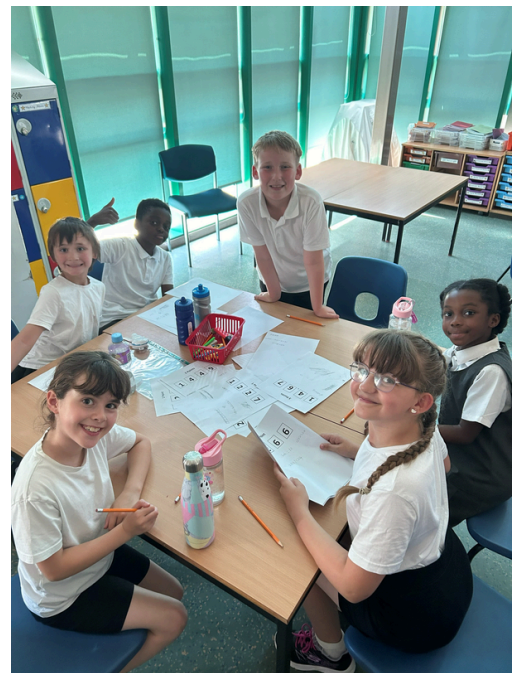
Maths Championships

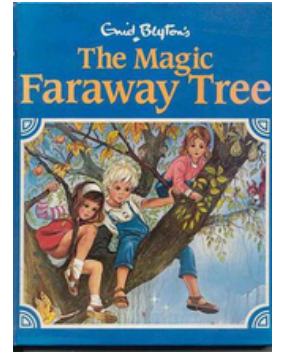
Water Safety Week
