A person acknowledged as Holy or virtuous.

Canonised

Declared a saint

Icon

A devotional painting of Christ or other Holy figure.

Symbol

A representation of a holy person.

What does the word saint mean?

There are more than 10,000 saints in the Roman Catholic church.

Christians pray to saints to guide and help them.

Those who are killed because of their faith are called martyrs.
