
Fair and right.

How can following God bring freedom and justice?

The Old Testament tells the story of the Children of Israel (People of God).

Moses is a great prophet and leader of his people.

The story of Moses tells how he rescued his people, the Israelites (Jews), from slavery in Egypt.

Outcomes

- Explain connections between the story of Moses and the concepts of freedom and salvation.
- Make connections between Bible texts and what Christians believe about how they should behave.
- Explain how Christians put their beliefs into practice by trying to bring freedom to others.
- Comment on how Bible texts about freedom and justice are helpful or inspiring.

Moses led his people out of Egypt to freedom by crossing the Red Sea, which God parted, to help

At Mount Sinai, God spoke to Moses and made a deal (covenant).



God gave the Jews a set of rules to live by - The Ten Commandments.
